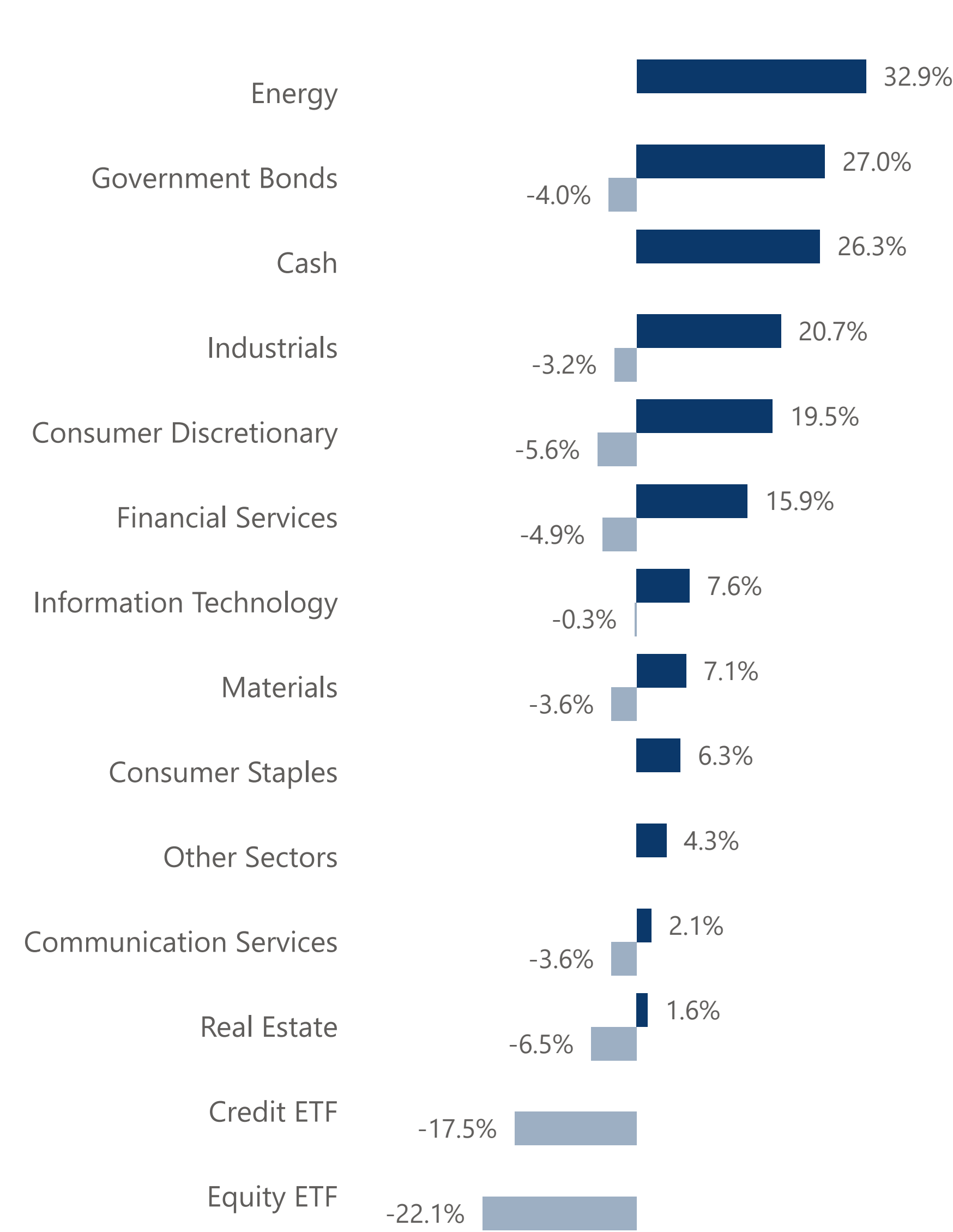

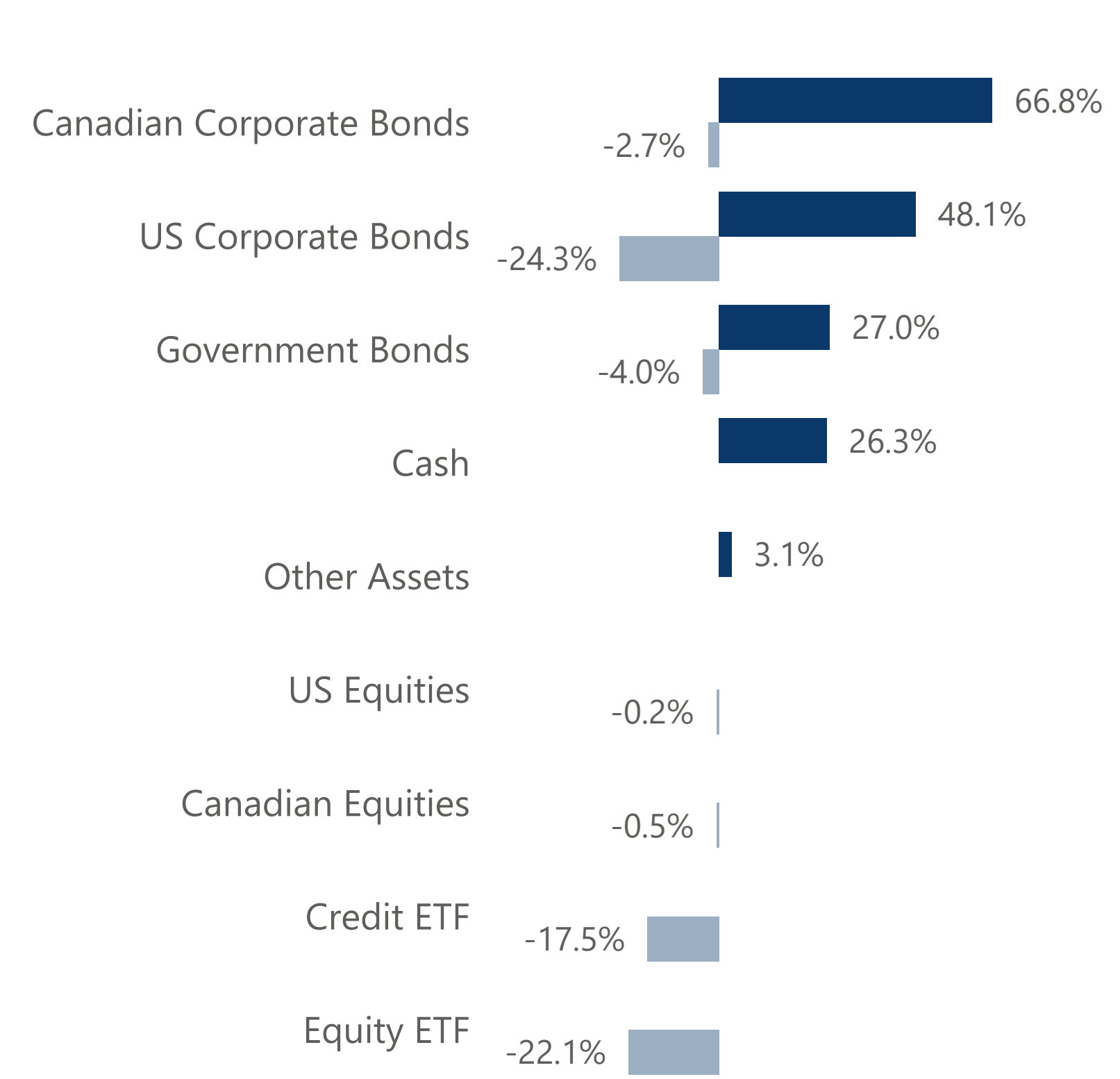

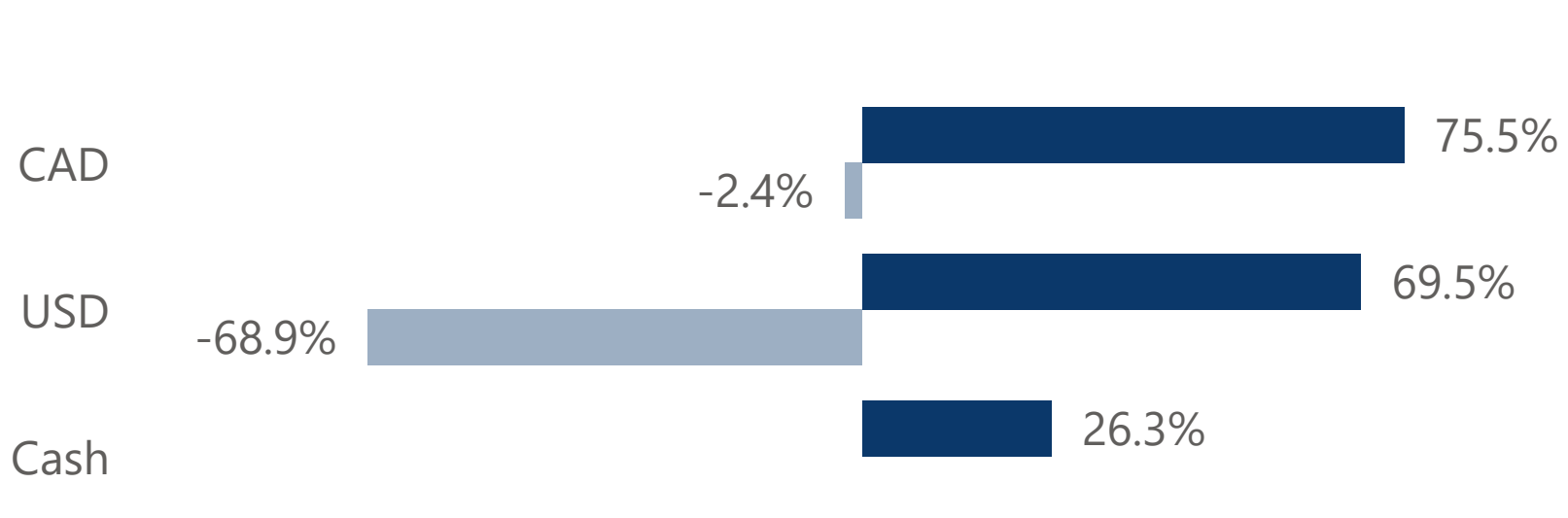
SECTOR ALLOCATION

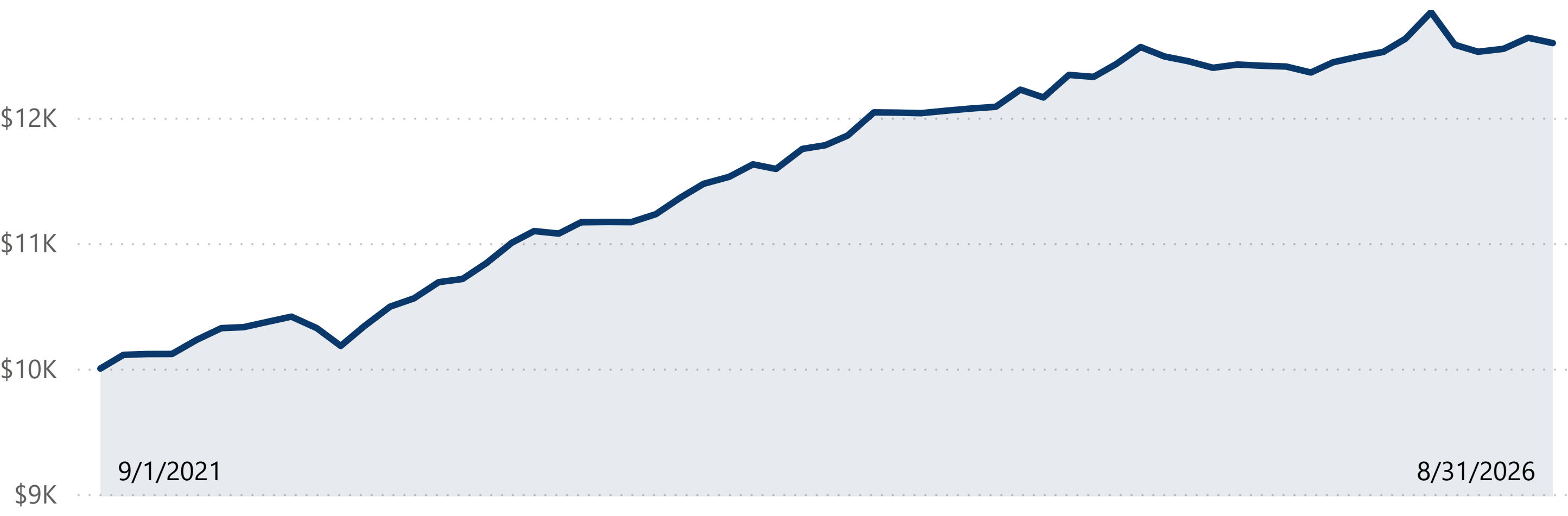
